To all to whom the presents shall come Greeting.
Know Ye that Thomas Crow of Ross county Ohio, having deposited in the Treasury a certificate of the Register of the Land Office in Chillicothe whereby it appears that he has made full payment for the south west quarter of Lot 02 Section number Twenty five of Township number Ten, in Range number twenty one (Worthingtons Survey) of the Land directed to be sold at Chillicothe by the act of Congress entitled "An act providing for the sale of the Lands of the United States in the Territory north west of the Ohio and above the mouth of Kentucky River" and of the acts amendatory of the same, There is Granted by the United States unto the said **Thomas Crow** the quarter lot on section of Land above described. To have and to hold the said quarter lot or section of Land with the appurtenances unto the said **Thomas Crow** his heirs and assigns forever.
